#### 5/60 Water Watch Program



On Monday 5/60 participated in water testing to help determine the effectiveness of a constructed wetland which will be built as part of the Wirraway housing development at Thornton.

Jane Lloyd-Jones, School Engagement Officer from Hunter Local Land Services, firstly visited us in our class and talked about storm water pollutants in the catchment and simple, everyday things we can all do to help

protect the quality of the Hunter River. We also learnt about purpose of the constructed wetland in the housing development. We were then planning on visiting the site to test the water, but the weather wasn't very nice, so instead Ms Lloyd-Jones brought the water to us.

We tested samples of water taken from both upstream and downstream of the constructed wetland, to see if there is any difference in water quality between the 2 sites. The purpose of the constructed wetland is to improve water quality of the storm water runoff from the surrounding urban area. The wetland will have a rich diversity of plants and animals which can act as filtering systems, removing sediment, nutrients and pollutants from storm water before it reaches the Hunter River. The wetland will also reduce the peak rate of runoff, helping to prevent localized flooding and reduce streambank erosion downstream.

Next year Ms Osborn plans on continuing to work in conjunction with Hunter Local Land Services to enable students to monitor the quality of the water in our local waterways.




