

2018 Organisation

Planning is well underway for 2018. Our school continues to grow quite quickly and these last few weeks have seen more new enrolments for 2018.

We are currently working on placing our expected enrolments of 664 students in 2018 classes and teacher allocations. We are unable to let children know what class they have for next year, as enrolments are still being accepted for local (in-zone) students. If you are aware of any families who are yet to enrol, please encourage them to come into the school office or phone for an enrolment package.

New Classrooms

Our new demountable building is ready for handover next week. We have placed another request for a further classroom for the start of 2018.

Staffing

There are a number of staff changes for 2018. We are currently awaiting the appointment of at least 2 new classroom teachers.

The Principal Bulk Recruitment process is underway to fill the vacancies created by the appointment of 35 new roles of Director, Educational Leadership which commence in Term 2 2018. Mr Millburn has been appointed in one of these new roles. The Principal position for our school is part of this recruitment process. Local panel interviews will be held in Term 1 2018. Mr Tony Gadd (Relieving Director Public Schools NSW) will be at the P&C meeting on 5th February 2018 to discuss the selection process and a parent/community representative for the local panel interviews.

A huge thank you to NSW environmental trust for providing funding to support schools developing environmental programs.

In 2015 our school applied for a \$3500 Eco Schools Grant to further develop our endangered Lower Hunter Spotted Gum Ironbark Forest remnant. As you may already know, Thornton Public School is situated on 9 hectares of ground in the middle of Thornton. Our school buildings and grounds take up approximately half of this area. The rest is our treasured forest. Over the years we have applied for many grants to help preserve this forest for future generations.

We recently completed this Eco Schools grant, which involved clearing weeds, developing a learning track for students to engage with the environment. This forest is very close to the original state. We purchased gravel and mulch, seats, signs and seedlings to restore this particular area. Conservation Volunteers Australia came for 2 days to weed the specified area as well as our Junior Landcare group who helped to mulch the path. The end result is spectacular. We hope to continue restoring the rest of the area in the coming years. Thornton Public School Canteen operates under the NSW Healthy Canteen Strategy. The aim of the canteen is to provide healthy food options to the students and staff at reasonable prices. We are open every day for lunch and afternoon tea.

THORNTON PUBLIC P & C CANTEEN MUNCH N EAT

Thornton Public School P & C Canteen age currently transitioning the menu to come in line with the new Healthy School Guidelines. We have been working on our menu over the past 12 months and are very close to complying with these new guidelines.

The guidelines state that the menu needs to have a ratio of 75% everyday foods and a maximum of 25% occasional foods. As we already had many healthy options our transition to the new strategy should not be too difficult. We would love our families to encourage regular selection of the everyday items on the menu.

Our canteen operates Monday to Friday for lunch and afternoon tea. Students can order for either break. We offer over the counter orders, or for your convenience we offer online ordering. We use flexischools.com.au for our online ordering. Occasionally we will have special items that appear on our online menu only, for ease of catering. The setup for flexischools is very easy and just requires you to create a login and either direct debit or transfer funds via visa/MasterCard. Once you have credited the account you can start to order. This saves lining up and ordering over the counter and the students remembering to come to the canteen to order.

At lunch time, the teacher sends two students up to the canteen to collect the class lunch box and they hand out the lunches to the students. If the student has an afternoon tea order, each individual child needs to come to the canteen to pick up their order.


We are always in need of volunteers to help out in the canteen. Any time you can give us by volunteering would be a great help, even if it is only for half an hour or an hour in the morning. Our busiest time is from 9.00am until 11.30am and this is when we would like extra volunteers. A volunteer can go on our roster one day per month or even one day per term, Grandparents are also welcome to help out. The kids love seeing their parent/carer in the canteen. If you have a friend that you would like to come and volunteer with, we can put you on the roster together.

If you have any questions about the canteen, our menu or how the canteen operates, please don't hesitate to call in and see us.

Who can apply?

To be eligible for a School Opal card, students may need to live a minimum distance from their school:

Years K-2 (Infants)

There's no minimum distance.

Years 3-6 (Primary)

1.6km straight line distance or 2.3km walking.

Years 7-12 (Secondary)

2.0km straight line distance or 2.9km walking.

How to apply

Step 1

Complete the application at **transportnsw.info/school-students**

Step 2

Print, sign and date the completed application, then submit it to the student's school for endorsement.

Step 3

The school then sends the endorsed application to Transport for NSW. Once approved, the School Opal card will be sent to the address provided on the application.


